# About the Ministry



## 19<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the National Board for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (NBMSME)

- Ministry of MSME organised 19th Meeting of the National Board for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (NBMSME) on 11.01.2023 under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Union Minister for MSME at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi in the august presence of Hon'ble Minister of State (MoS) for MSME.
- During the meeting, deliberations were held with stakeholders for strengthening the MSME Sector which inter-alia include measures to enhance the impact of schemes and access to credit for MSMEs, addressing delayed payments, redressing MSME grievances etc.
- On this occasion, Hon'ble Union Minister (MSME) has launched a portal, 'Udyam Assist Platform' (UAP) for bringing Informal Micro Enterprises (IMEs) in the formal ambit, for availing the benefit of Priority Sector Lending.

## Suriname delegation visited NSIC's Rapid Incubation Centre and Advanced Training Centre

A delegation led by Mr. B. Gangaram Panday, Managing Director, Electric Lighting and Technical Company (ELTO), Suriname visited NSIC's Rapid Incubation Centre and Advanced Training Centre at NSIC Technical Service Center (Okhla), New Delhi on 20.01.2023. The delegation was apprised about the activities of NSIC and discussion on possible cooperation areas between NSIC and Suriname were also held. The delegation observed that NSIC's model of Rapid Incubation Centre for employment generation and Advanced Training Centre is also required for development of MSMEs in Suriname. They appreciated NSIC's facilities for skill development and creation of self-employment opportunities.

Under this mutual cooperation agreement, both NSIC and PHD Chamber of Commerce & Industries Chambers will work together to provide information, guidance and help to MSMEs in availing various schemes of the Government, Ministry of MSME and NSIC particularly in its schemes of Single Point Registration Scheme, NSIC's Bank Credit Facilitation Scheme, International Cooperation Scheme, NSSH scheme, Raw Material Assistance Scheme.





## Research & Development in the month of January 2023

- Central Tool Room & Training Centre (CTTC), Bhubaneswar has did machining of Ground Nozzles for M/s Manastu Space Technology, Mumbai, which is developing Green Propulsion system for Satellites.
- Indo Danish Tool Room (IDTR), Jamshedpur designed and manufactured a press tool for thermocouple sensor connectors (for export to Japan and other Countries) for M/s Allied Instruments & Thermocouples, Jamshedpur.
- Central Tool Room (CTR), Ludhiana developed Press tool for 'Tactile Braille Ruler' (measuring scale for blind people) for 'National Institute for the Empowerment of the Persons with Visual Disabilities (Divyangjan)', Dehradun.

## MSME SAMBANDH – Public Procurement Policy

Implementation of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small enterprises is monitored through 'MSME SAMBANDH' portal. Up to 31.01.2023, the procurement details of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) during FY 2021-22 & FY 2022-23 are as follows:

## Self Reliant India (SRI) Fund

- As reported by NSIC Venture Capital Fund Limited (NVCFL), 34 Daughter funds have been empanelled under the SRI Fund and under the aegis of NVCFL (Mother Fund), financial assistance has been provided to 140 potential MSME beneficiaries by the Daughter funds so far.
- During January, 2023, Rs. 35.15 crore has been released to NVCFL. During FY 2022-23 (up to 23.01.2023), Rs. 212.57 crore has been released to NVCFL.



## Credit Guarantee Fund Trust for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE)

During the month of January, 2023, 83,125 guarantees have been approved involving an amount of Rs. 6,537 crore during January, 2023. During FY 2022-23, a total of 9.26 lakh guarantees involving an amount of Rs. 78,380 crore have been approved.



## Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP)

During the month of January 2023, Margin Money Subsidy of Rs. 276.61 crore was disbursed by Banks under PMEGP, which will facilitate setting up of 8,691 micro enterprises creating employment of around 69,528 persons.



## Capacity Building and Augmentation

### Training & Placement:

- 216 trainees trained by MSME Tool Rooms & Technical Institutions [Central Tool Room & Training Centre (CTTC), Bhubaneswar, Indo Danish Tool Room (IDTR), Jamshedpur, Indo German Tool Room (IGTR), Aurangabad, Central Tool Room & Training Centre (CTTC), Kolkata, Central Institute of Tool Design (CITD), Hyderabad and Central Institute of Hand Tools (CIHT), Jalandhar] have been placed in various enterprises located at Karnataka, Telangana, Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra and Punjab.
- 26,257 persons have been imparted skill training through various organizations under the Ministry viz., Tool Rooms & Technical Institutions, New Technology Centres established under Technology Centre Systems Programme (TCSP), National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) Ltd., Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), National Institute for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (ni-msme) & Coir Board during the month of January, 2023.
- As on 24.01.2023, under the 'Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme' (ESDP) scheme, 229 programmes were conducted benefitting 10,873 persons during the month of January, 2023.

### Tool Room & Training Centre (TRTC), Guwahati had undertaken following major activities during the month of January, 2023:

- Trained 1,610 candidates in various NCVT/SCVT Certificate and Diploma courses such as Machinist, Turner, Welder, Computer Hardware & Network Management, Steel Fabrication, Plumber, CNC Machining, CAD/CAM, PLC, Auto CAD & Catia etc.
- Rendered services to 37 units including MSMEs by manufacturing tools & components.
- 42 trainees have been placed in different industries of Assam.



## Assistance and Handholding

During the month of January, 2023, 18 Tool Room & Technical Institutions spread across the country are providing trained personnel assisting MSMEs for various job works, testing & calibration, consultancy services such as designing and manufacturing of dies and tools, moulds, jigs and fixtures, CAD/CAM, etc. 2,761 units were assisted by these Tool Room & Technical Institutions.



## Extension Centres

35 locations for ECs have been approved, out of which, Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) of 26 ECs have been approved. 18 ECs have started training/ assisting MSMEs.

During the month of January 2023, 17 ECs have trained 1,909 trainees and assisted 33 MSMEs.



## Coir Board

20 firms were newly registered as Coir Exporters and issued Registration-Cum-Membership Certificates in January, 2023 and 72 officials were trained under HRD.



## MSME Champions Scheme

MSME Champions Scheme has been formulated with three components namely, 'MSME-Sustainable' (ZED), 'MSME-Competitive' (LEAN) and 'MSME-Innovative' (Incubation, Design, IPR). Digital MSME will be interlinked with all other components of the Scheme. Funds sanctioned to Central Tool Room, Ludhiana, as Central Nodal Agency (CNA) of Raising and Accelerating MSME Performance (RAMP) scheme in the month of January, 2023 are as follows:

- Sanction of Rs. 2.46 crore on 06.01.2023 for 24 approved Design projects under Design Component.
- Sanction of Rs. 1.17 crore on 16.01.2023 for onward release to National Productivity Council (NPC) towards pending liabilities under the erstwhile 'Lean Manufacturing Competitiveness Scheme (LMCS)'.
- Sanction of Rs. 1.07 crore on 16.01.2023 for onward release to Quality Council of India (QCI) towards previously approved clusters under the erstwhile 'Lean Manufacturing Competitiveness Scheme (LMCS)'.

## National SC-ST Hub Conclave

Ministry of MSME organised **National SC-ST Hub Conclave at Mumbai, Maharashtra on 23.01.2023 to promote entrepreneurship culture and spread awareness of the NSSH Scheme and other Schemes of the Ministry.** Hon'ble Union Minister of MSME Shri Narayan Rane graced the occasion with his presence along with other senior dignitaries. The event saw the participation of around 450 SC-ST aspiring and existing entrepreneurs. The session provided an interactive platform with CPSEs, lending institutions, etc. where CPSEs like Nuclear Power Corporation India, Konkan Railways, Mazadon Dock Shipbuilders Limited and Mumbai Port Trust gave presentations on their vendor empanelment process and details of products/services to be procured. The Financial institutions such as SIDBI, IFCI Venture Capital Funds, Union Bank, and State Bank of India, detailed various lending schemes pertaining to the MSME sector. Other Government organizations like KVIC, Coir Board, and GeM also participated in the program and deliberated on their schemes for MSMEs. The program also had facilitation desk for UDYAM Registration and stalls of MSME-DFO, MSME Testing Center, IDEMI, Coir Board, KVIC and few SC/ST entrepreneurs.
